Purpose of Workshop

The purpose of the workshop was to discuss the City of Jacksonville Beach's Alcohol Ordinance.

City Manager

Ms. May reviewed a draft of City Ordinance No. 2019-8116 [on file] regarding Alcoholic Beverages. Ms. May offered additional options regarding increasing or reducing restrictions.

Conversation ensued, and the following topics were discussed:

- Transferability of permits/licenses
- Infraction outline and penalties
- Locations affected by the proposed ordinance change
- Grandfathering in current businesses serving alcohol
- Required security cameras and personnel

Updates to the drafted ordinance would be as follows:

- Three violations would result in a revoked permit
- Police Department would approve the security standards

Additional data (consisting of an updated table of SRX and 4-COP facilities both in and out of the CBD) would be gathered and presented to the Council at a future briefing or workshop.
