
URBAN TRAILS - Definition



A citywide network of non-motorized multi-use pathways that are used by bicyclists, walkers and runners for both transportation and recreation purposes.

Urban Trails -- Goals



1. Create a network that is easy to access. No point is further than a 5-minute bike ride or 10-minute walk from an urban park or trail.
2. Make trails wide enough to accommodate both recreation and transportation uses.

3. Incorporate trail amenities and features such as rest areas, wayfinding signs, lighting, shade and landscaping etc.
