Project: Phase IIIC-Project 1 Infrastructure Imp's-1st, 2nd, & 3rd St. S.(Beach Blvd. to 4th Ave. S)and 1st, 2nd, 3rd. & 4th Ave's S.(Atlantic Ocean to 3rd St. S.)

Project Improvements Overview

The contractor will be constructing the following items:

1. Asphalt Roadway Reconstruction.
2. Demolition of existing Sidewalks and Structures.
3. Sidewalk Reconstruction and Replacement.
4. Curb Demolition and Replacement.
5. Relocation of the Existing Streetlights.
6. Modify Existing Electrical Vaults.
7. Replacement of Existing Roadway Signing & Striping.
8. Minimal Landscaping and Irrigation System Repairs.
9. Traffic Control and Maintenance.
10. Maintaining of Business Access.
11. Storm-water System Reconstruction.
12. Water Distribution System Replacement.
13. Sanitary Sewer System Replacement.
14. Provide Additional On-road Parking.

The improvements are intended to be more user friendly for both vehicle and pedestrian traffic and also improve public safety.

NOTE: The Contractor will be replacing the existing 12 inch water main located within 2nd St. South as his first phase of construction. Work will start at Beach Blvd. and continue southerly to 4th Ave. South. It is anticipated that this particular work will take approximately 2 months to complete.

Project Overview: During the construction phase, due to the excavation for the installation of the new storm-water drainage system piping, water and sewer main piping, roadway replacement, landscaping and sidewalk work, the roadway will be torn up and there will be times when local residents may not be able to access their driveways during the normal work hours. During these times, business customers & residents may have to park in the surrounding areas until the roadway is backfilled and available for access. At the end of each day, all driveways will be accessible. The goal is to complete this project with a minimum of inconvenience and we ask for your patience during this construction project.
