PROJECT OVERVIEW

Reconstruct public infrastructure and improve drainage within the project area, as necessary. Project work includes:

- Roads
- Sidewalks & curbs
- Major stormwater drainage improvements
- Public parking
- Modify electrical system
- Water mains
- Sewer mains
- Connect new drainage to the 12th Ave. S. Stormwater Basin
- Concrete pave alleyways
- Upgrade pumps at the Beach Blvd. Stormwater Vault

PROJECT UPDATES:

Project updates are planned on a periodic basis as the construction work proceeds.

During the excavation phase of this project, the roads will be torn up and there will be times, during normal working hours, when local residents may not be able to access their driveways. During these times, business customers and residents may have to park in the surrounding area until the roadway is backfilled and available for access. All driveways will be accessible at the end of each day. Our contractor has already video taped the project area to establish the existing conditions prior to starting construction. As construction progresses, the contractor may be contacting individual property owners to identify the location and condition of their private irrigation systems within the project area. Any irrigation systems damaged by the contractor will be repaired by the contractor at no cost to the property owner.
