RESOLUTION NO. 2030-2019

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE
SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY ONLINE**

WHEREAS, it is hereby declared that certain personal property owned by the City of Jacksonville Beach is in excess of the foreseeable needs of the public, and for that reason it is in the best interest of the City that the same be put up for public online auction and sold to the highest bidder(s) after providing the required public notice. A list of surplus items will be maintained by the Property and Procurement Officer and will require approval of either the City Manager or the Deputy City Manager prior to the Bid Process.

WHEREAS, the public will be allowed sufficient time to inspect the surplus property prior to commencement of the public online auction.

WHEREAS, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BEACH AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. After providing proper public notice, the surplus items will be disposed of by conducting an online auction open to the public.

Section 2. All items shall be sold in, as is, where is, and without warranty.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
