Corridor Overview - 1st Street, Greenways, Penman Road



MISSION STATEMENT:

Create a multi-modal urban trails network for the City of Jacksonville Beach that provides safe access and usability for all ages and abilities of residents and visitors.

GOALS and OBJECTIVES



CONNECTIVITY

Connect the City's multiple green spaces and parks into the overall network to create a comprehensive looped system, including the golf course.



ACCESSIBLE

Provide shared use paths for users to enjoy recreationally and to traverse from important origins and destinations throughout the City.



SAFTEY

Prioritize safety for all users through separated trails, the use of lighting and safe, dedicated crossings (particularly at A1A).



SENSE OF PLACE

Develop a complete wayfinding system, to assist users in navigating the trail network and reinforce the strong sense of place of being in Jacksonville Beach.



MULTI-MODAL

Accommodate a wide range of multi-modal travel including pedestrians, bicycles, strollers, roller bladers, skateboarders, and scooters.



POLICY

Provide policy recommendations and guidelines for improving transportation connectivity and mobility throughout the community.







- > A dedicated corridor through green belt or similar area
- Nature-oriented
- Little traffic exposure along trails (although there may be roadway crossings)
- Safe environment for all levels of experience and ages of users

- Consider "growing" the network to these corridors.






