Pursuant to Section 34-815 of the Jacksonville Beach Land Development Code, within one (1) year of the approval of a development plan for plat, an application for Final Plat shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable fee of \$250.00, plus \$20 per lot. Four (4) copies of the application with attachments shall be submitted for review.
