ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

a. South Beach Redevelopment Improvement Project Opportunities

Due to time constraints, this item was carried over to a future workshop meeting, tentatively scheduled for March 16, 2020.

b. Downtown Delivery Truck Parking

Mr. Jones provided Agency members with a draft proposal of the substantive sections of an ordinance for delivery restrictions in the Downtown District for discussion purposes. Several restrictions were discussed, including but not limited to: public safety, the types of allowable and prohibited vehicles allowed to park in the area for delivery purposes, prohibiting parking on specific streets, authorization for the City Manager to grant waivers, and enforcement of the ordinance during peak seasons. Mr. Jones will revise the proposal and it will be resubmitted for review at a future meeting.

c. Status of Redevelopment Attorney Contract Related to the Consolidation of the Downtown Plan and Its Amendments

Mr. Mann stated the contract previously approved by the Agency on January 21, 2020 will be submitted to the City Council for its review on March 2, 2020.
